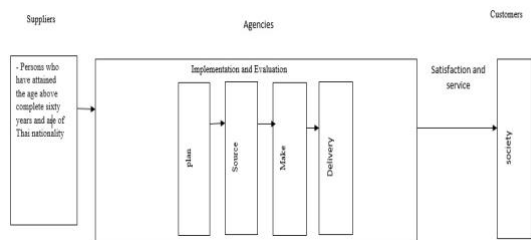


Figure 1: Information system for elderly care management in Thai supply chain.
